Dave spoke to Erin at the Goff House and the new prices for rental are \$250 for a four-hour block, and \$40 to \$60 for rehearsals. The basement is no longer available for storage. Hope Church is also a possibility and Roy will stop in to see if it is a viable venue.

We are still awaiting an answer from Ken Barber about our 501C3. Cindy has been in contact with Ken. He is still working on it.

Meghan will look into writing up a grant proposal for the Art's Commission with the help of Valerie. \$300 could pay for sound for the talent show. It was discussed that we could possibly pay for someone to help build a set. We discussed also getting putting the money into new headsets, Walkie-Talkies, a new sound board or COM system.
